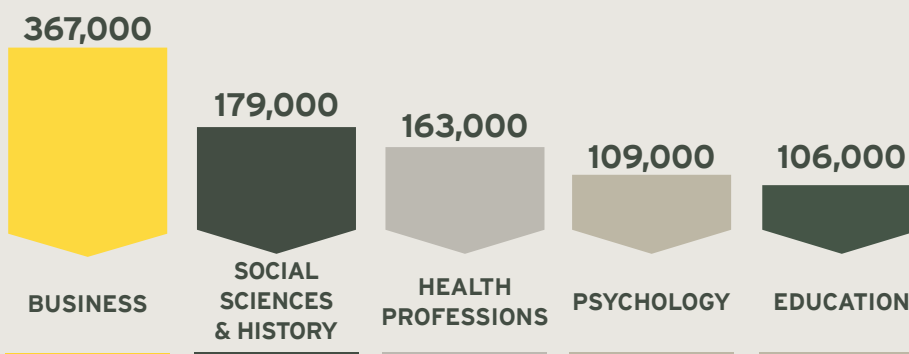

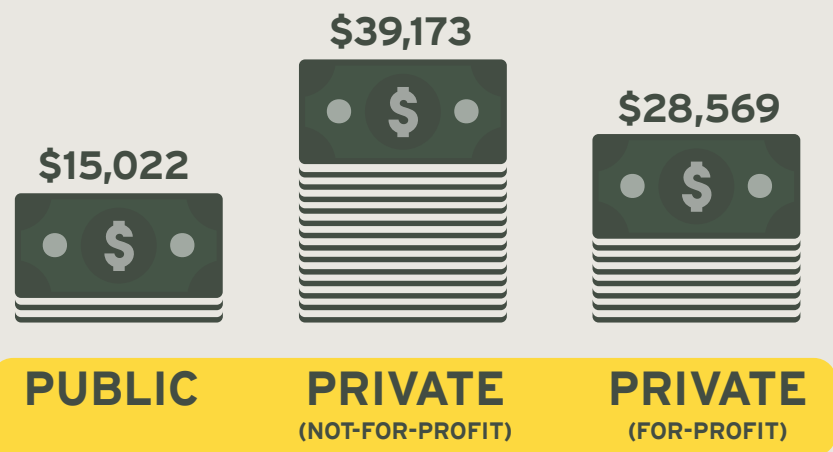

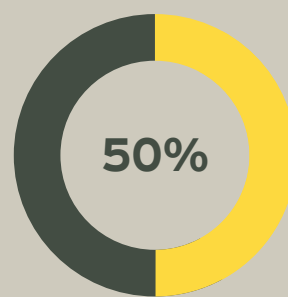

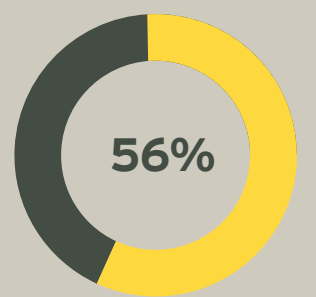
ANNUAL CURRENT DOLLAR PRICES FOR UNDERGRADUATE TUITION, ROOM AND BOARD

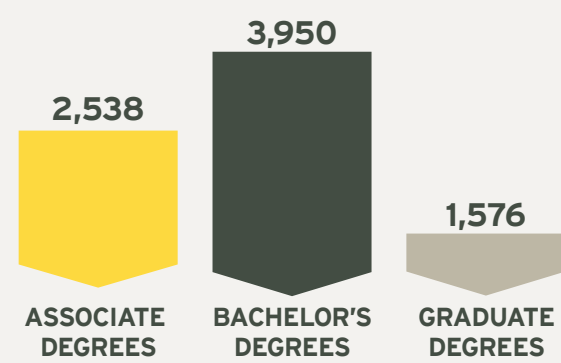

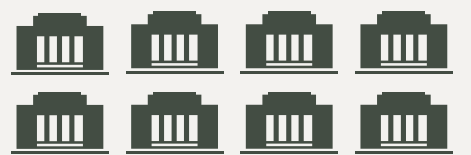
