

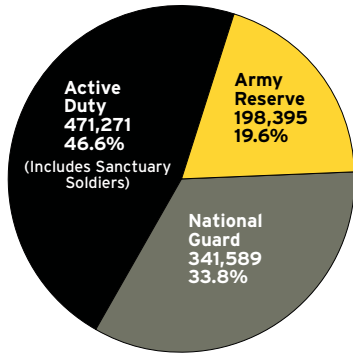

#### TOTAL STRENGTH OF THE ARMY

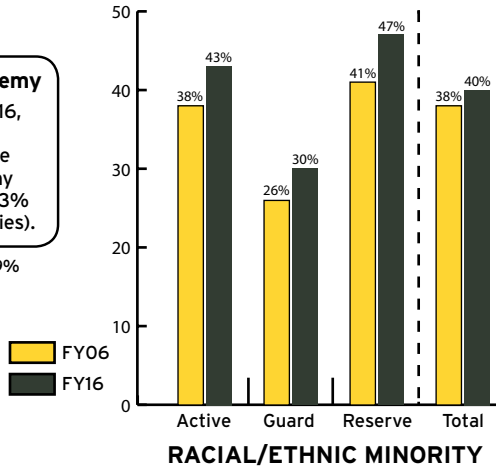

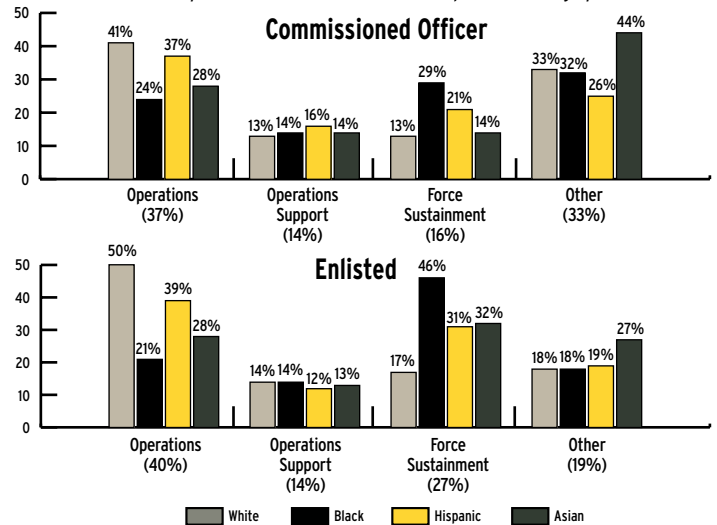

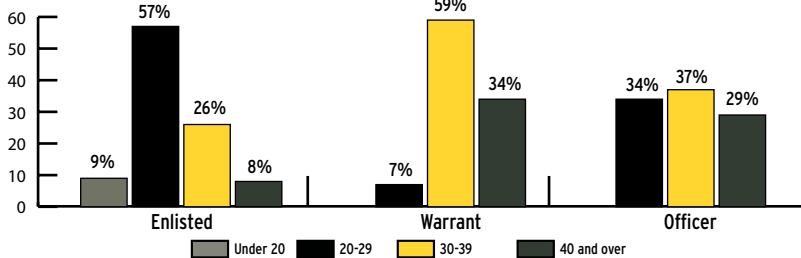

#### ACTIVE DUTY ARMY BY BRANCH AND RACE/ETHNICITY, FY16

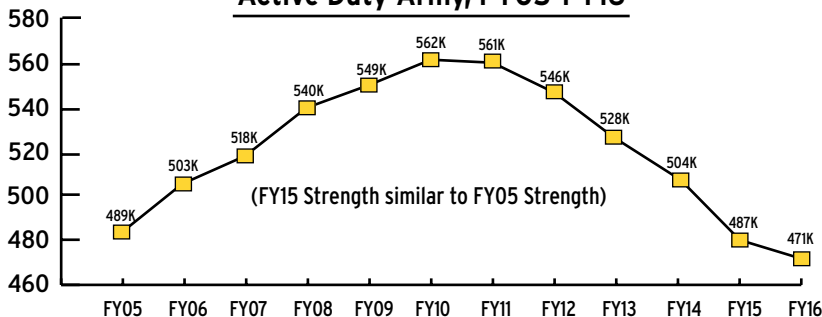

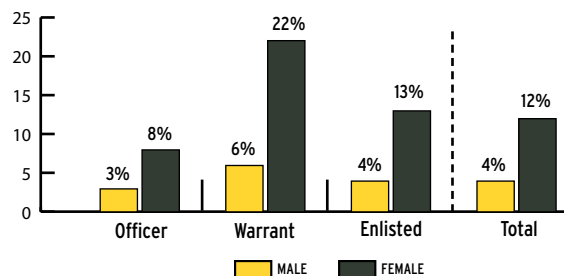

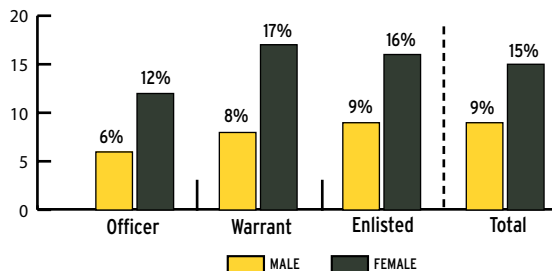

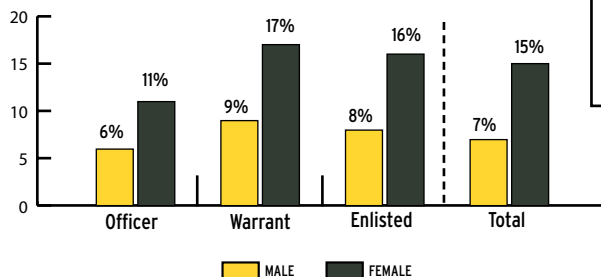

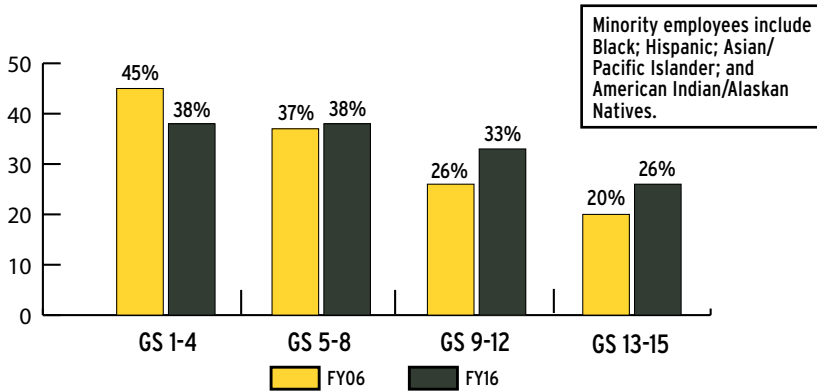


Female Reservists are more likely to be single parents than are male Reservists.

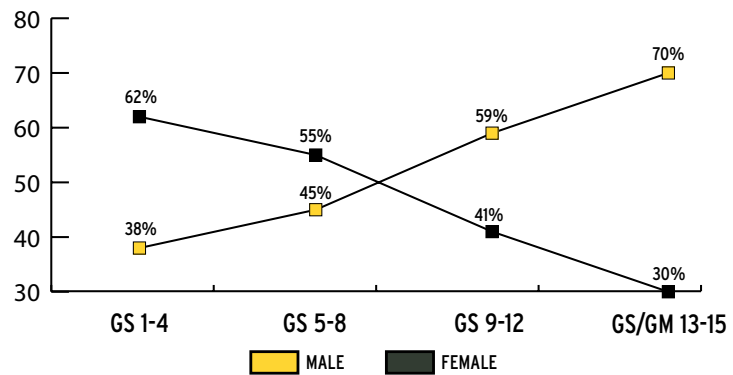
